

Terms and Conditions

BOOKING AND FEES

1. The price for the course is the quoted price on the online calendar for each individual date booked.
2. A non-refundable reservation fee of £100 is required to secure your child's place on the course, at the time of booking.
3. The full fee for the course/courses booked is payable no less than 2 months prior to the commencement of the course.
4. Should you wish to cancel the place, written notification must be received, no less than two months prior to the commencement of the course.
5. We reserve the right to request full payment for cancellation after this time.
6. Any booking and deposit submitted will be confirmed by email.
7. COVID 19. By booking, you the parent/carer accept that by attending the course, your child will be together with other children, which brings inherent risks of infection. Whilst we will try to reduce the risk, we cannot eliminate all possibility of contagion. It is therefore your choice whether you allow your child to attend or not.
8. In the light of the recent COVID pandemic, we reserve the right to switch any course from live to online, should we deem it in the best interests of health and safety for either pupils or teachers.

GENERAL

2. We are responsible for the children during the designated course hours only, which are clearly displayed on the website.
3. All children must be accompanied by a responsible adult to and from the hall at the commencement and end of each day.
